


Water Cycle Game



Water is used by people to **cook meals.** Many foods are cooked in water.

Next turn: go to Waste Stream.

Water is used by people to water agricultural plants. This is called irrigation. Water from both wells and surface sources are used.

Next turn if you roll:

- 1-5 -- go to Ground Water.
- 6 -- water runs off soil where it is used and ends up in a river; go to River.

Water is used by people to **flush** toilets. Toilets are one of the largest users of water in a house.

Next turn: go to Waste Stream

Water is used by people to **cool equipment**. Often factories get
their products very hot, and they
will pour water over them to
cool them off.

Next turn: go to Surface Water.

Water is used by people to clean themselves. Taking a bath or shower or washing your hands in a sink all use water.

Next turn: go to Waste Stream

Water is used by people to make products that are sold in stores. Beverages such as sodas and canned foods are two examples. Because the products stay on the shelf for awhile, lose next turn and then go to Waste Stream

Water is used by people to brush their teeth. Water is used in homes and commercial settings. When finished water ends up in waste system. Next turn: go to Waste Stream.

Water is used by people to water lawns and gardens. This water goes back into the ground. Next turn: go to ground water

Water is used by people to wash clothes. A washing machine can use as much water as a long shower or bath.

Next turn: go to Waste Stream
